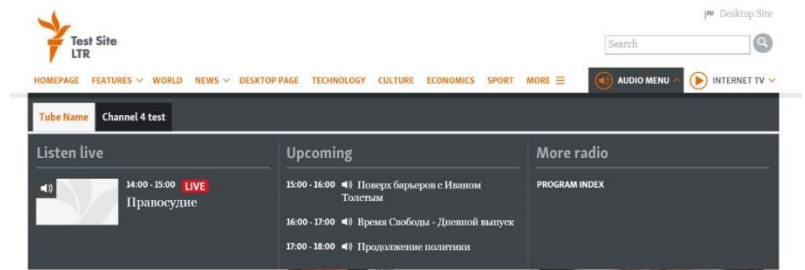
New Features – Responsive Web

- **Multiple tubes Audio navigation**

In this release Pangea brings a new feature to Responsive for services with **Multiple Audio Channels**.

If your service is set to stream audio in more than one channel, the channels will be highlighted on media navigation, letting the user see all the options the services have for streaming. This is a feature is enabled automatically if you have multiple tubes set up in Pangea.

It is essential to have a proper name for the tube set on Pangea as the name of the tube will be displayed in media Navigation.

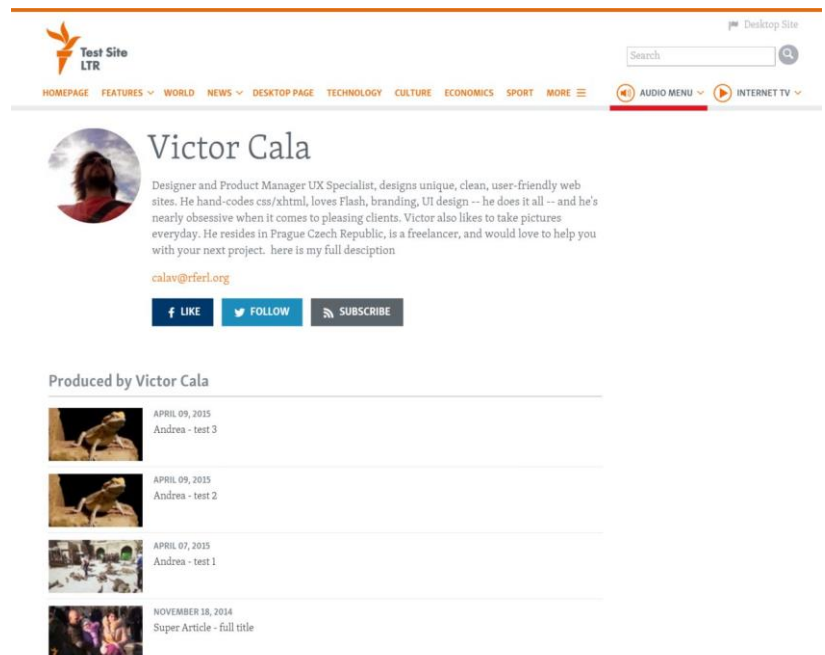


- **Responsive Author page**

Our team is also releasing an Author Page to Responsive, setting up the page in CMS is easy as before. If the authors are already setup for desktop, the changes will be available automatically to the responsive design, this page will allow visitors of the site to:

4. Access the latest content produced by this author

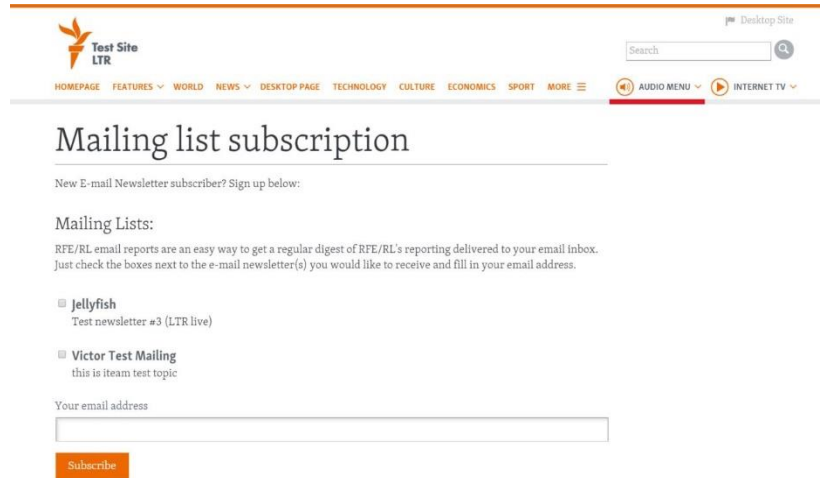
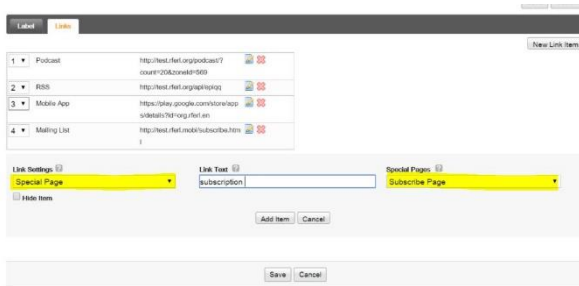

- **Responsive Subscription Front-end**

In this release Pangea also introducing the subscription page for Responsive, this page will allow visitors to subscribe to your email campaigns ([for more information about Pangea Emailer please visit Showcase](#))

This page is automatically set up if you have emailer set for desktop, the only thing you need to do is to add a link to the page, you could use top navigation or footer navigation; select option **special page** and then **subscribe page** when creating the link.

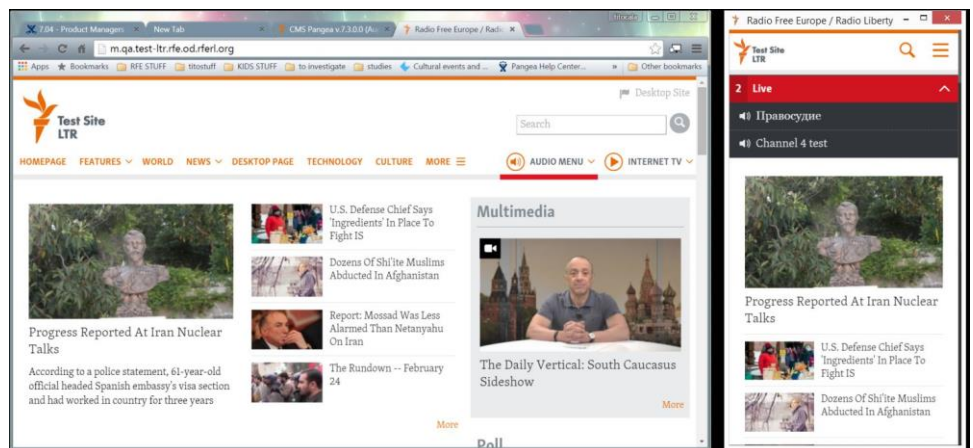


- **Live Highlight**

And finally based on your priceless feedback during our Responsive roll-out sessions in D.C., Miami and Prague we are bringing the most wanted and anxiously awaited feature to Responsive.

A Live stream highlights functionality which means if there is a live stream for audio or video, the system will prompt users on mobile sites by displaying live bar, indicating what program is live at the moment, on a click user will be directed to the player and could start listening or watching the program.

We believe this feature will help you to promote Live Audio/Video and your audiences will benefit from it by not missing on live programs.



New Features – CMS & core apps

- **Social Media Teaser**

For most of our content types we added new Teaser - Social Media Teaser. This teaser won't be seen anywhere on the site, but only when user share/insert link to social media.

For those who are not certain how this feature might be beneficial, here is brief description: Since most of social networks have limits for number of characters in the title and introduction text we wanted to provide you with a solution that allows you to create teaser that meets social networks sharing standards and give you opportunity to display catchy title and image.

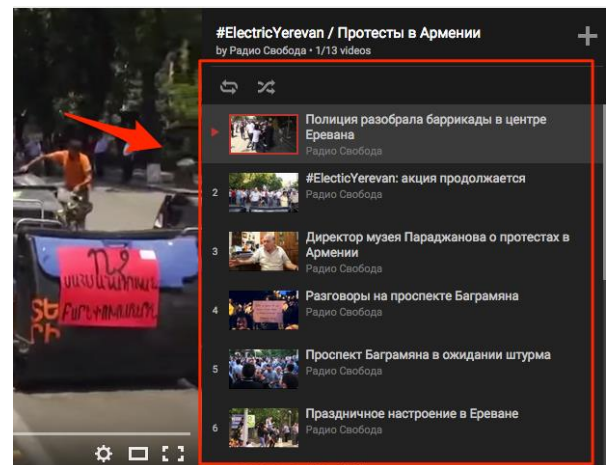

In CMS edit page we will have one additional tab called "Social Teaser Info". If editors in CMS won't filed Social Media teaser, we will use normal Teaser details and if that is not available, we will use main Image, Title and Description instead.

- **YouTube Playlist and Full Screen capability**

In this release we've improved the YouTube embedding feature. It newly supports **playlists** and also **full screen** capability.

User could copy the code for playlist and just paste it in CKEditor, CMS will provide correct view on the page. Full screen will be supported for any YouTube embed videos.



- **Social Share of Poll**

From this release your audiences will have the option to share their poll voting to Social Media (Facebook, Vkontakte, Twitter, Google+, Pinterest). Poll doesn't have dedicated page, so visitor will share link to poll archive page. Localization for this new feature is required and highly recommended (new keys are already available in CMS)

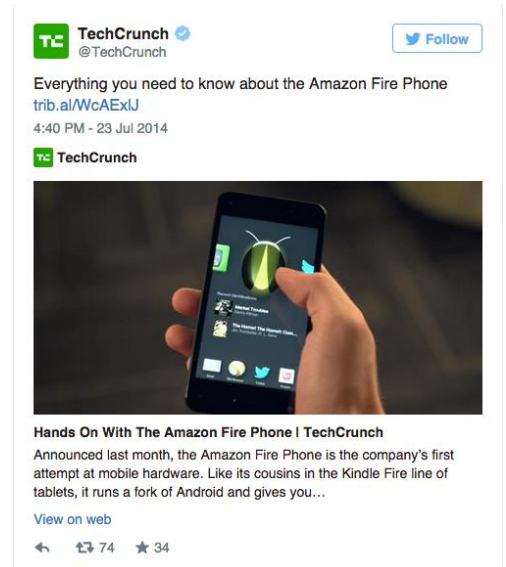


- **Twitter Summary Card with Large Image**

Fixed and Known Issues

First of all we'd like to thank all of you for using the new ticketing system. The system currently hold over 110+ tickets while over half of them are already closed. We'd you to encourage to check the status of your issue by following [this link](#). Just for your information we've processed and closed about 100 internal bugs during this development cycle.

See some of the most critical issues:

- **Pangea TV Widget** – the issues announce on the [Pangea Help Center](#) has been successfully fixed in the upcoming release 7.03
- **EXIF Metadata - unresolved** – we're very sorry but we were not able to resolve the issue with reading metadata information from some JPEG files during GDB upload. As you may know Pangea CMS were unstable during last couple of months and after our analysis we found out that the code for retrieving EXIF data was causing such problems. As part of 7.02 we've replaced the code by another functions which appeared to be not reading properly EXIF data from some specific JPEG files (saved in older Photoshop versions). Two of our senior developers are working on the fix and we believe to provide the fix as soon as possible. ([SUPPORT-271](#), [SUPPORT-354](#))
